Reading Challenges are for everyone, kids, adults, teens, and families. We encourage you to read widely and explore the library and the world around you. This summer the theme is “Imagine Your Story,” celebrating folk and fairy tales, imagination, and storytelling.

Earn embroidered patches/badges for each challenge.

This summer the challenges are Fairytales, Maine History, and Searsport.

To earn a patch, read 5 books (appropriate to your reading level) and do 5 activities related to the theme.

Pre-readers/family readers read 10 books and do 5 activities.

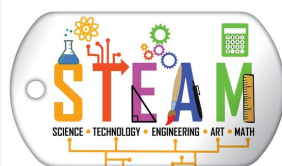
On paper: logs available at the library or on our website.
